



Richard Lush (VP/Route Logistics Coordinator): Richard Lush is currently the executive director for clinical research operations at the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center & Research Institute (MCC). He received his B.S. in Pharmacy (1987) and Ph.D. in Clinical Pharmaceutical Science from the University of Pittsburgh (1994). After his graduation he spent three years working in the Clinical Pharmacokinetics Laboratory at the National Cancer Institute (NCI). During that time he worked with the investigators as part of the intramural phase I program at the NCI. Phase I studies usually involve giving new investigational agents to patients for the first time and are the earliest part of clinical research. In 1997 he was recruited to the Moffitt Cancer Center to help initiate a Florida-based Phase I program. He developed the clinical pharmacology laboratory which has grown to become part of a bigger core laboratory that supports clinical research at MCC. He also helped establish the Clinical Research Unit to provide an appropriate clinical setting in which to conduct early phase clinical research studies.
